CP2: -----San Pedro Lighted Buoy B: Y "B" FI Y 6s----- 50 yards stbd  
CP3: -----L.A. Channel Lighted Approach Buoy: R"2" FI R 2.5s ----- 50 yards stbd  
CP4: -----LA Entrance East Light: FI R 2.5s 42ft 4M "8"----- 75 yards stbd  
TP: -----Turn point - Not a checkpoint - Turn at corner of Middle Breakwater ---- 75 yards stbd  
CP5: -----Long Beach Light: FI 5s 50ft 20M HORN ----- 75 yards stbd  
CP6: -----San Pedro Precautionary Area Buoy: Y "A" FI Y 4s----- 50 yards stbd  
CP7: -----Anaheim Bay Entrance Buoy: G C "3"----- 50 yards stbd  
Finish:----Pier J Channel Lighted Buoy: R "2" FI 4s (W of Island Freeman) -- 300 yards abeam
