Eligibility: ----- Members of SCCA member yacht clubs in conformity with SCCA rules.

Trophies: ----- Keeper trophies in accordance with SCCA rules.

Points:----- Fall Series, Top-Ten, Bathke, Simonson, NACA, and Lurie First-Year Racer.

Rules:----- SCCA Cruiser Navigation Contest Rules April 11th, 2007, as amended.

Observers: ----- Family members OK as this is the feeder to an overnight race.

Committee boat:-- RM II HYDE

Skipper's meeting:None

Official scorer: ---- Tom Collins – NO HANDICAP SCORING WILL BE USED.

Predicted log:----- To be sealed in an envelope and given to the observer before the contest.

Actual log: ----- Use SCCA log form dated 11/28/05; Turn in logs with official clock immediately after the Del Mar contest to the scorer, Tom Collins, on the vessel Misty Sea as soon as possible after mooring but no later than 1430 hours.

Awards:----- In conjunction with the Champagne Cup & Del Mar awards in Cat Harbor.

Dress: ----- Casual beach attire.

The Course

START: ---Range on LONG BEACH LT FI 5s 50ft HORN and LA breakwater west -----
----- 50 yards starboard

CP-1:-----Y "B" FI Y 6s ----- 50 yards starboard

CP-2: -----R "2" FI R 2.5s ----- 50 yards port

CP-3: -----33° 39' 28.42" N / 118° 17' 16.78" W

CP-4: -----33° 39' 33.06" N / 118° 20' 45.95" W

CP-5: -----33° 41' 28.60" N / 118° 24' 55.58" W

WP-1:-----33° 42' 58.71" N / 118° 26' 41.47" W

FINISH: ---33° 45' 55.04" N / 118° 26' 49.66" W

(Official distance is approximately 18.7 nautical miles)

Special Instructions

NOTE A: Plan a start time for the Jack Kahlo Memorial contest so as to allow sufficient time to finish the Jack Kahlo Memorial 0.5 nautical miles from R "10PV" FI R 4s BELL, proceed to R "10PV", start the Del Mar contest with the R "10PV" buoy within 50 yards to starboard, and meet the Common Time Finish for the Del Mar contest.

NOTE B: Be aware that contestants finishing the Champagne Cup may be passing R "10PV" within 50 yards to port at approximately the same time as your planned start of the Del Mar contest.

1. Any and all equipment aboard the vessel may be used except that which is prohibited.
2. Use of the following data from any source is prohibited:
 - a. Clock time or elapsed time.
 - b. Vessel speed (except as derived from an engine tachometer).
3. This contest WILL allow an Open Log where during the contest the skipper may have access to all times recorded on the Actual Log.
4. Race communications: VHF 71.
5. NO start time penalties will apply.
6. Charts: 18749 – Ed. 43, 04/2010; 18751 – Ed. 46, 08/2009; 18746 – Ed. 38, 11/2009.
