Skipper's meeting: -----Skippers' meeting at Seal Beach Yacht Club patio on Friday, October 7th, at 1830. Use a start time of 0900 on Predicted logs. Actual start times will be assigned at the skippers' meeting. Turn in Predicted logs at the skippers' meeting.

Logs: -----Use SCCA latest revision. Turn in Actual logs at the Alamitos Bay Marina Bureau harbor office dock (near the gas dock) to the Seal Beach Yacht Club committee boat. Contact them on VHF Channel 71.

CP-1: ----R N "4" ----- 50 yards stbd
CP-2: ----Oil Platform EVA----- 200 yards port
CP-3: ----Y "A" FI Y 4s ----- 50 yards stbd
CP-4: ----G "1" FI G 4s BELL -----50 yards port
CP-5: ----East end Long Beach breakwater FI G 62 43ft 5M "1" HORN ----- 100 yards port
Finish: ----Island Chaffee east MARKER (LIGHTED) ----- 100 yards port

Notes & Rules:

- 1 Start Time: **PLAN** a start time of 0900. Adjusted start times will be assigned at the skippers' meeting with a two-minute separation. Fast boats starting first.
- 2 Contest prepared using charts: 18749 – 43rd Ed, 18751 – 46th Ed, 18746 – 38th Ed.
- 3 Official distance: 16.8 nautical miles.
- 4 Contest will be scored with speed handicap.
- 5 Race communications: VHF 71.
- 6 All equipment aboard the vessel may be used except that which is prohibited.
- 7 Use of the following data is prohibited:
 - a. Clock time or elapsed time.
 - b. Vessel speed (except as derived from an engine tachometer).
