Commodore Marla Brown welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. She thanked Ivan Cox of Ventura Yacht Club and Frank Sullivan of Channel Islands Yacht Club for their help in arranging the meeting. She reminded the group of the upcoming contests - the Tom Scott Memorial, Sept. 24, the Ramsey, Sept. 25, the A.A. Oakley, Oct. 2, and the Season Closer, Oct. 16.

REPORTS

Treasurer Report: In Treasurer Suzie Scott's absence, C/Brown reported that SCCA is solvent.

Secretary: Joanne Collins reported twenty attendees representing five yacht clubs.

Sanction Committee: All but the Season Closer, hosted by Shoreline Yacht Club, have been sanctioned.

Vice Commodore: Daryl Creighton encouraged all to participate in the upcoming Ramsey race and enjoy the historic Catalina YC and the luxury of a private dock with dinghy valets. He discussed his experience on the winning boat at the NAI in August and how impressed he was with the precision of the winning contestant, Bob Lindal of Seattle and his team. He also noted the importance of continuing efforts to gain new members to SCCA and encouraging sail boats to participate in Predicted Log racing. Next year's schedule is in the works and a proposed schedule will be published soon. There are no major changes. Work is also in progress for the installation in January.

Rear Commodore: Bill Winberg requested articles and pictures for the Skippers Log to be forwarded to him ASAP.

NACA: S/C Tom Collins reported on the NAI hosted by Shoreline Yacht Club in August. The comments from the contestants indicated they found the race to be challenging. Our own John Walker came in third, St. Petersburg's Fay Baynard was second, and Bob Lindal from Seattle came in first. Next year the NAI will be in St. Petersburg, 2012 in Chicago, and 2013 tentatively in Vancouver. He also noted that R/C Bill Winberg has been voted in as one of the four NACA Directors at Large.

NEW BUSINESS

Following a question on up-to-date copies of the SCCA Rule Book, S/C Collins stated that S/C Craig Ryan is maintaining the Rule Book by incorporating any changes as they occur. A follow-on question pertained to the availability of the pocket size printed copies that were previously issued. S/C Collins indicated he would follow-up with A/C Ryan on that matter.

There being no further business, C/Brown declared the meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm.

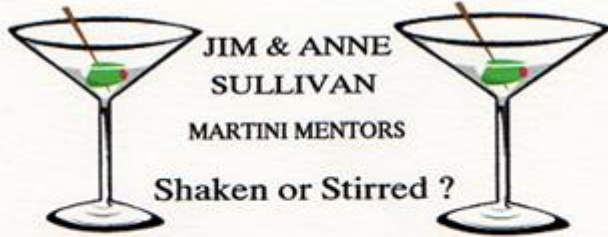
