VICE COMMODORE'S COMMENTS, April 2011:

For most of last race season, and continuing this season, the race format has allowed for more use of our navigational electronics than had been allowed for many years. Some of us have appreciated the opportunity for increased use of the same equipment we would be operating if we were at sea but not involved in a predicted log competition.

The old argument based on "when electronics fail," has pretty much fallen by the wayside as advancements in chips and processors has opened a new generation of marine navigational systems. Today's GPS's are so cheap you can have backups for your backup. Loran, and everything proceeding it is now outdated. Trans-Pac's announcement that having a sextant on board for navigation is no longer a requirement sort of sums it up.

Having completed only two seasons of predictive log racing, I have personally learned more about the driving force of tides, currents, wind and how they do **not** go in lock-step with one another, than I would have ever imagined. With the rapid advancement of electronics, the thought of Black Boxes and complicated wire runs is no less confusing. However, I do know that experience and knowledge of basic seamanship serves the same purpose as electronics, - - to guide a vessel and its passengers safely from point A to point B. Our sport of log racing seems to be one of the most interactive ways of bringing it all together and making boating easier, safer, and more enjoyable.

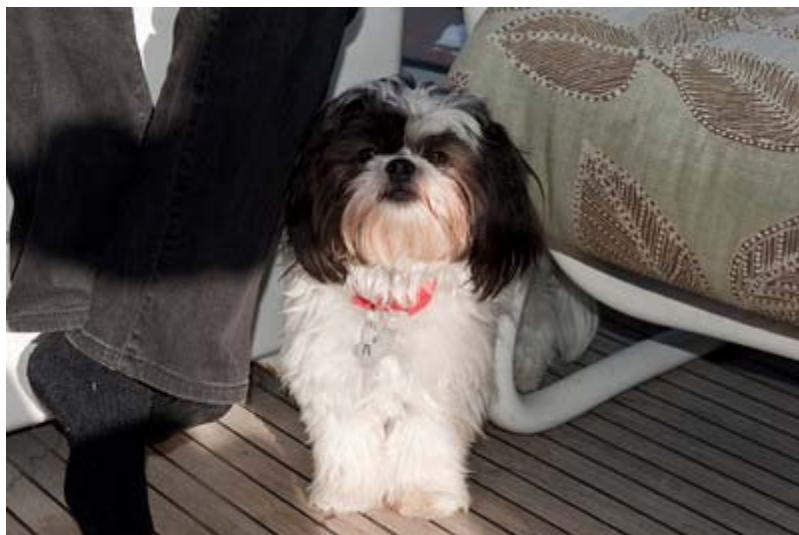
