At 8:10 p.m. Commodore Marla Brown welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. After thanking Hollywood Yacht Club Commodore JD Smith for arranging dinner at the Naples Rib Factory she introduced SCCA V/C Daryl Creighton, and R/C Bill Winberg.

SCCA Staff Commodores in attendance were: Tom Collins-1980, Bob Roth-1986, JD Smith-1998, Tom Chandler-2002, and John Walker-2006. Following tradition those in attendance introduced themselves, spouses, and guests.

REPORTS

Treasurer Report: In Treasurer Suzie Scott's absence, C/Brown reported a balance of \$5,892.23.

Secretary: Joanne Collins reported 18 attendees represented six yacht clubs.

Rules Committee and NAI Update: S/C Tom Collins reminded the group that the SCCA Rules and much more SCCA information is posted on the NACA website: predictedlog.org, listed under Southern California Cruiser Association. He also reviewed the upcoming NAI to be held August 4 through August 7 at Shoreline Yacht Club (Schedule of Events attached). One area of concern is the need for boats for the contestants. There are eight confirmed contestants with a possible addition of one more. Currently only six boats have been offered for use in the NAI. He also noted that there are still a few Committee Chair openings. There was further discussion regarding banners for the event, as well as a Sat. night event conflict being resolved at Shoreline YC.

Sanction Committee: John Willister reported that the races comprising the Craig Contest (the Shaffer, the Donaldson, and the Corredores) would be received by the membership early next week.

Vice Commodore: Daryl Creighton reported that BCYC Commodore Don Bernard recently expressed interest in working on getting more BCYC member participation in predicted log racing.

Commodore: Marla Brown expressed thanks for the support she has received in preparing for the Barusch Contest to be held June 17 through June 19 in San Diego. She particularly thanked S/C John Walker and wished him good luck in the Barusch. She also noted that the September SCCA meeting would be held at Channel Island Yacht Club in Oxnard. Even though it is a long way for many SCCA members, she encouraged attendance at the meeting to support the log racers in that area.

NEW BUSINESS

CRAIG/CORREDORES/TSYC: S/C Bob Roth reviewed this year's non-traditional Corredores race, which will depart SDYC on Mon. to go around the Coronado Islands and then return to SDYC on the same day. This change will save many fees, fuel and slip costs. There will be a Mexican theme dinner at SDYC that evening. Please reply promptly to the dinner reservation forms for both the SDYC dinners and the LBYC dinner. He also reminded the group that carrying ones passport is important, even though we will not be stopping or staying in Mexico. Discussion followed regarding the necessity of stopping at Customs at the end of the race. Clarification of current rules will be forthcoming prior to our departure.

S/C Tom Collins reviewed the possible activities associated with TSYC Opening Day, Tues., 7-13, at SDYC. Consideration was given to what activities were desired and where the appropriate area would be at SDYC. He will follow up with SDYC. There was also discussion regarding destination options Wed. morning following our stay at San Diego YC. Anchoring in Mission Bay was suggested. Discussion followed.

Pabst Race: S/C Bob Roth notified the group that California YC no longer leases Ballast Point where the activities related to the Pabst take place. He is in the process of making arrangements for use of the picnic area near the Cat Harbor pier. Due to the location change, the event will start at 6 pm. Since logistics are now a bit more challenging, the traditional bottle of Champagne will be given to each skipper at the time of log pickup so it can be chilled prior to dinner. The dinner will continue to be catered by the Harbor Reef.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Pabst Race Feeder: The leg from Long Beach to the start of the Pabst (the HYC Jack Kahlo Memorial race) will be run and scored as a feeder race.

Season Closer: Shoreline YC is the host club and various aspects of organizing this new contest were discussed.

Sharkie Trophy: Where is it? Members are encouraged to check with their yacht clubs to see if it is hiding among other trophies. It was noted that the currently inactive Interclub Reisen trophy is currently residing at LBYC and is in need of some tender loving care.

Jan Ryan issued an invitation to SCCA members to Hollywood Yacht Club's summer BBQ on July 24 to be held around the pool at JD and Vicky Smith's Portofino complex in Huntington Harbour. She also mentioned the HYC Pirates Cruise held Sept. 18 at Tom Rumsey's home in Long Beach.

Crew Needed: George Jackman is looking for a crew/observer for the Craig Race, as are Daryl and Madelyn Creighton.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 pm.

SOME HISTORY OF THE TODOS SANTOS YACHT CLUB

On the Craig Race this July we'll be celebrating the 31st anniversary of the Todos Santos Yacht Club. Certainly many of you aren't even aware of the Clubs existence. Perhaps some brief history is in order. Originally the Craig Race ran from Long Beach to San Diego on Friday and returned on Sunday. San Diego Cruiser Association racers would race up on Thursday and we all ran down together on Friday and the scores from the various legs were combined to determine the winner.

There had also been the Hall Scott contest in August that ran down to San Diego and then was followed by the SDYC International contest that ran from San Diego to Ensenada, Mexico.

Two things happened to change all of that. First there was the oil shortage with all the long lines around gas stations waiting to buy fuel. Although boat fuel wasn't that difficult to get, there was an attitude of conservation that sparked an undertone of fewer and shorter races to conserve fuel. Combine that with the fact that a key figure at San Diego Yacht Club became miffed at the Mexican authorities and decided to pull SDYC's support for their International contest.

Consequently SCCA decided to remove both the Hall Scott and the International from the calendar and instead to change the Craig so that the second leg would replace the SDYC International. Thus was born the International Corredores de Baja, the second leg of the Craig.

A few of us who had been going over to anchor at south Todos Santos island (about nine miles west of Ensenada Harbor) on the SDYC International invited the now larger group of skippers on the new Corredores race to come along.

At this juncture the idea of creating a Todos Santos Yacht Club was born. Seemingly all at once there was a set of officers, rules and even a burgee. An opening day ceremony was the highlight of the group and games were plentiful. Incidentally, one of the rules was that the membership fee to join was one Mexican Peso and the resignation fee was \$10,000 U.S!

With the added feature of the TSYC, the popularity of the cruise to Todos Santos Islands grew and eventually we managed to fit as many as 22 boats into a cove that the cruising guides said could hold one or two boats.

Obviously the TSYC was created in the spirit of fun and it continues to live on in the same tradition. Long live the whimsical Todos Santos Yacht Club!
