### Marine Service Charts & Dial-A-Buoy

If one is planning any trips up and down the West Coast (or Gulf or Atlantic Coast), the most valuable weather information one can have for "harbor hopping" the coast is by using Marine Service Charts for the area one is in or going to be in conjunction with Dial-A-Buoy.

The Marine Service Charts can be purchased from the NWS for \$1.25 each or downloaded for free as a GIF or PDF file. For our area in Southern California, MSC-8 – Mexican Border to Point Conception, CA, there are several buoys that give wave and wind reports continuously updated usually by the hour.

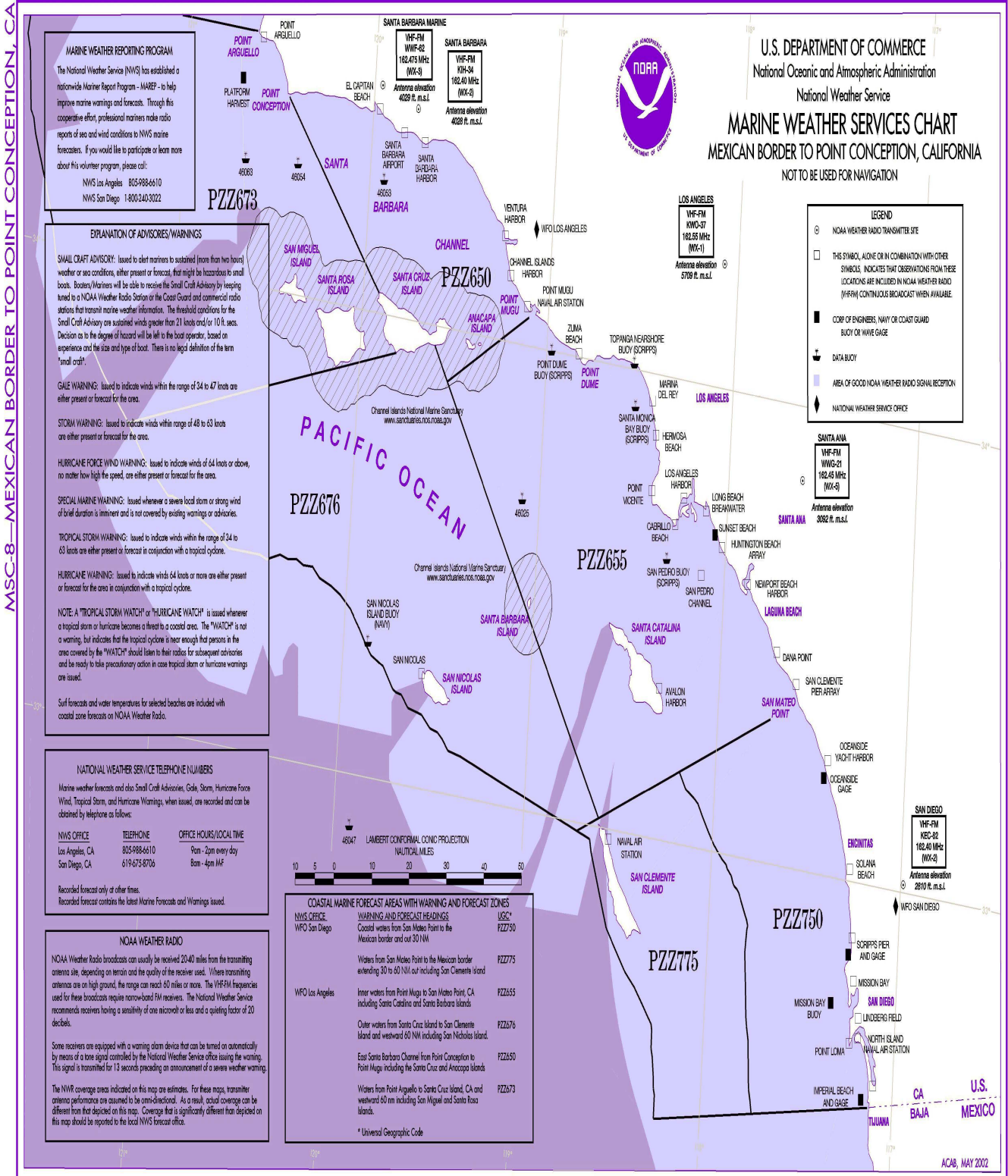
For example, Dial-A-Buoy 46053 is located in the eastern Santa Barbara channel just south of Santa Barbara Airport. If one is heading for Pt. Conception, calling ahead to find out the wave and wind conditions as well for the buoys around Pt. Conception and Pt. Arguello would be prudent. Dial 1-888-701-8992 and follow the prompts. The voice will ask you to select "1" for a numbered buoy; then it will ask for the five-digit number. The current wind and wave report will follow and then the prompt will as if you want a forecast for the area.

The MSC-8 can be downloaded at <http://www.nws.noaa.gov/om/marine/images/msc8f.pdf> and will show the buoy positions and numbers. The charts also have the closest VHF WX channels listed as well as visual descriptions of the areas covered by the reports. When traveling up the coast and using the MSC-10 chart for Point St. George to the Canadian Border, if a report is heard for "Cape Blanco to Gold Beach inshore waters" and we are new to the area, the MSC-10 chart will show the boundaries of the area which is being mentioned. The MSC charts have an enormous amount of information both on the front map side and also on the back side. Virtually any weather information one could want can be obtained from sources on these charts.

There are offshore buoys that are located about four-hundred miles offshore that will give an advance warning of any weather systems moving toward the coast. If the offshore buoy is reporting gale force winds and big waves in a cold front moving rapidly east, one can be alerted ahead of time that the near-shore conditions in an area that one is headed might very quickly go from calm to Small Craft to Gale conditions.

I have used these MSC Charts and Dial-A-Buoy personally on two trips up the coast to Washington state and two trips southbound. As the commercial for American Express says... "Don't leave home without it." I wouldn't contemplate any trip north or south along the West Coast without these services. The charts for the West Coast are MSC-8 – Mexican Border to Point Conception, CA; MSC-9 – Point Conception, CA to Point St. George, CA; and MSC-10 – Point St. George, CA to the Canadian Border. At 8:20 p.m. Commodore Marla Brown welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order. After thanking Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club for a great dinner she introduced SCCA V/C Daryl Creighton, R/C Bill Winberg, Secy. Joanne Collins, Rules Tom Collins, Treas. Suzie Scott, and F/C Jan Ryan. SCCA Staff Commodores in attendance were: Tom Collins 1980, Bill Findley 1987, JD Smith 1998.

#### REPORTS

**Treasurer Report:** Suzie Scott reported the current account balance is \$5,617.23 and all bills are paid. She noted that due to the passing of S/C Jack Kahlo, his donation for the Brugman trophies has ceased. Expenses are down this year, particularly due to reduced mailing and printing costs.

**Secretary:** Joanne Collins reported a quorum and 15 attendees.

**Rules Committee:** S/C Tom Collins reminded the group that the SCCA Rules are posted on the NACA website: [predictedlog.org](http://predictedlog.org), listed under Southern California Cruiser Association.

**Sanction Committee:** John Willister reported that Tom Collins has written a “whoopee-do” Donaldson race. He suggested bringing spare batteries for calculators. The Corredores will feature something not done in 20 years. Dana Point continues to express interest in joining SCCA contests. The logistic challenges of distance etc. were discussed and how best to accommodate their concerns.

**Fleet Captain:** Jan Ryan gave a colorful report on the reason for the bandages she, her mother (Peggy Bent) and S/C JD Smith were sporting.

**Vice Commodore:** Daryl Creighton discussed the reasons (bad weather) for the cancellation of the Marina Cup saying he has learned a lot about weather websites, particularly SailFlow.com. He reported that SCCA received a request from SCYA to switch Ramsey race date with their event at CIYC this Sept. Tom Collins gave some historical background to this continuing conflict of dates. SCCA is open to switching, but further discussion with SCYA is needed. At this time the Ramsey Race remains scheduled for Sept. 25. The issue of the new feeder races was raised, particularly the Channel Islands YC feeder race to the Ramsey. It is unknown at this time if one has been written. Commodore Marla Brown to follow-up. Also discussed were the weather issues going north in Oct.

#### OLD BUSINESS

S/C JD Smith suggested reaching out to Dana Point, perhaps by letter, to help resolve any issues and encourage their participation in SCCA. (Late flash: DPYC has rejoined for 2010)

#### NEW BUSINESS

A raffle was held to help support NAI. Thanks to Jan Ryan for donating the prize of a bottle of wine.

**Barusch:** S/C Tom Collins gave a brief background on the Barusch contest, which is to be held in San Diego this June. SCCA contestants eligible to participate in the Barusch are John Walker and Bill Winberg. Since Bill will be unable to attend, Craig Ryan is next in line.

**NAI** – S/C Tom Collins reviewed the history of the NAI from its start in 1973. He noted that SCCA is the responsible organization for conducting this year’s NAI with Shoreline Yacht Club hosting the event. The NAI scheduled for Wednesday, August 4 thru Saturday, August 7. Craig and Jan Ryan, members of SCCA

and Shoreline Yacht Club, are currently working on setting up committees and looking for volunteers. Jan reported the following volunteers to date: Tom Collins - Race Master, Micky Scheinbaum – Scorer, MikeSchachter - contestant boats, Jan Ryan and Vicky Smith - boat drawing, Suzie Scott - budget & finance, Vicky Smith - hospitality & tours, Joanne Collins - NAI Book. Jan mentioned the need for volunteers for the various responsibilities and events. Some of the committee openings include, publicity, box lunches, meals at SYC, and observers/scrutinizers. 
